

The fertility self-injections concerned her at first, but her physician showed her that they really were simple. The intended mother also went through a similar process, taking estrogen to prepare herself for the eggs.

Jess loved that Holly kept in contact with her throughout the process and that the intended parents paid for her egg donation bills.

Quick Recovery

When the day came, Jess and a travel companion went to have Jess' eggs retrieved. The procedure was quick, and after a day of rest and a movie marathon, she was back to her usual activities.

How do I become an Egg Donor?

Becoming an egg donor is one of the greatest things you can do for someone else. You will make an impact in others' lives with your caring heart and your willingness to reach out and help.

To be an egg donor you must

- Be female
- Be aged 21 to 28
- Be in good health
- Provide a medical history
- Not smoke and not use drugs
- Have a regular menstrual cycle
- Have a 18--28 BMI
- Not have tattoos or piercings within the last year
- Have a flexible schedule to attend medical appointments
